

INFORMATION NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In accordance with art. 13 of the Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), we inform you that the processing of your personal data by **Proevents & Conference SRL, as Data Controller**, with registered office in Bucharest, 60 Preot Vasile Lucaciu Str., sector 3 and correspondence address: Cluj-Napoca, 34-36 Someșului Str., Scala Center, Office no. 7, Cluj County, registered at the Trade Register Office under no. 1. Purpose and Legal Basis of Data Processing

Your personal data is processed on the following legal grounds:

- **Consent (Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR):** Data is processed for the provision of communications for marketing and advertising purposes, including to facilitate participation in future events in your area of expertise.

2. Types of Personal Data Collected

The data collected may include, as appropriate, identifying information (name, surname), contact details (e-mail address, telephone number), CUIM, specialty, professional grade, job, city, billing data.

3. Data Recipients

Personal data will be disclosed only to third parties, namely companies in the field of pharmacology relevant to your area of interest, as well as to processors who contribute to the proper performance of the controller's activity.

4. Duration of Data Storage

Your personal data will be kept until you withdraw your consent to the processing.

5. Rights of Data Subjects

Under applicable law, you have the following rights:

- Right to access
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure („right to be forgotten”)
- Right to restriction of processing
- Right to object
- Right to data portability
- Right to lodge a complaint
- Right to withdraw consent
- Additional rights related to automated decisions

6. Data Transfers Outside the European Union
