GDr. Samia Massalha is a senior cardiologist and cardiac imaging specialist at Rambam Health Care Campus. She holds advanced fellowships in cardiac imaging and adult echocardiography from the University of Ottawa Heart Institute, Canada, and has dedicated her professional career to multimodality cardiovascular imaging, with special interest in nuclear cardiology, cardiac CT, and cardiac MRI.

Dr. Massalha is actively engaged in academic teaching and international education, teaching medical students, residents, technologists, and nursing staff, and is a faculty member in international courses organized by the European Association of Nuclear Medicine (EANM) and the European Society of Cardiology (ESC). She is an active member of large international societies such as ASNC, SNMMI, and EANM, and is a member of the cardiovascular committee of EANM, participating in guideline committees, and is a reviewer and editor for top-tier journals in nuclear cardiology and cardiovascular imaging.

Her research interests include myocardial perfusion imaging, hybrid and multimodality imaging, applications of artificial intelligence in cardiac imaging, occupational radiation safety, and cardiovascular imaging in women. She has published many high-impact papers, consensus statements, editorials, and book chapters, and has been an invited speaker and chairperson at top international meetings such as ASNC, EANM, and ESC.

Dr. Massalha is dedicated to advancing education, innovation, and excellence in cardiac imaging and to mentoring the next generation of physicians through thesis supervision and international collaboration
